Community Booth Acceptance Policy

Waco Downtown Farmers Market desires to give back by featuring organizations and local businesses that add value to our community through education or outreach. For this reason, we offer a Community Booth space every Saturday at no cost to nonprofits, \$100 for businesses. All nonprofits and businesses are subject to approval by the WDFM's Operations Committee prior to participation at Market. We request that the organization/business promote its attendance at WDFM - and enhance our customers' experience.

Items offered for sale in the Community Booth must be approved by the Market Manager before the market day.

Site Details

- One 10' x 10' tent, one 6' table and two chairs are provided.
- Market Hours are 9am-1pm year-round (summer: 9am-12pm in July/Aug)
- Set up by 8:30am and have all vehicles removed from the site.
- Remain at your booth until the end of the Market.
- Anticipate 1500-3000 visitors.
- Access to electricity is extremely limited.

Rules

- Fundraising efforts require permission of market management and shall be limited to appropriate items that do not compete with regular market vendor sales, match the market's standards of healthy and local, and are in accordance with City and State health codes and licensing.

- Distribution of samples or free items must be cleared by market management and may require a hand washing station.
- If you would like us to include information about your booth in our social media or on our website please provide the information at least one week prior to your scheduled market date.
